The stream leaders will select an appropriate sample of refereed papers for submission to be awarded the Best Paper prize. Refereed papers will be published in the conference proceedings. Authors of selected papers will be invited to submit an extended version of their works for review and potential publication in the Special Issues of Middle East Journal Scientific Research (MEJSR), Malaysian Journal of Learning and Instruction (MJLI) and International Journal of Education and Training (InJET).

#### **Types of Submission**

Submissions should be made to one or more of the following categories, and all submissions will be subjected to blind peer review process:

Refereed papers: should be submitted as a full publishable manuscript with empirical findings, or conceptual/qualitative research articles. After acceptance, the full refereed papers should be formatted properly with no more than 6,000 words. The best paper awards will be selected from the accepted papers of this category only.

Work-in-Progress papers: Please submit an extended summary of your proposal/paper in no more than 3,000 words. These papers will be scheduled for presentation, and the abstracts will be included in the conference program. Work-in-progress (WIP) papers could be proposed conceptual framework based on extensive literature reviews, or research in progress papers with partial results.
